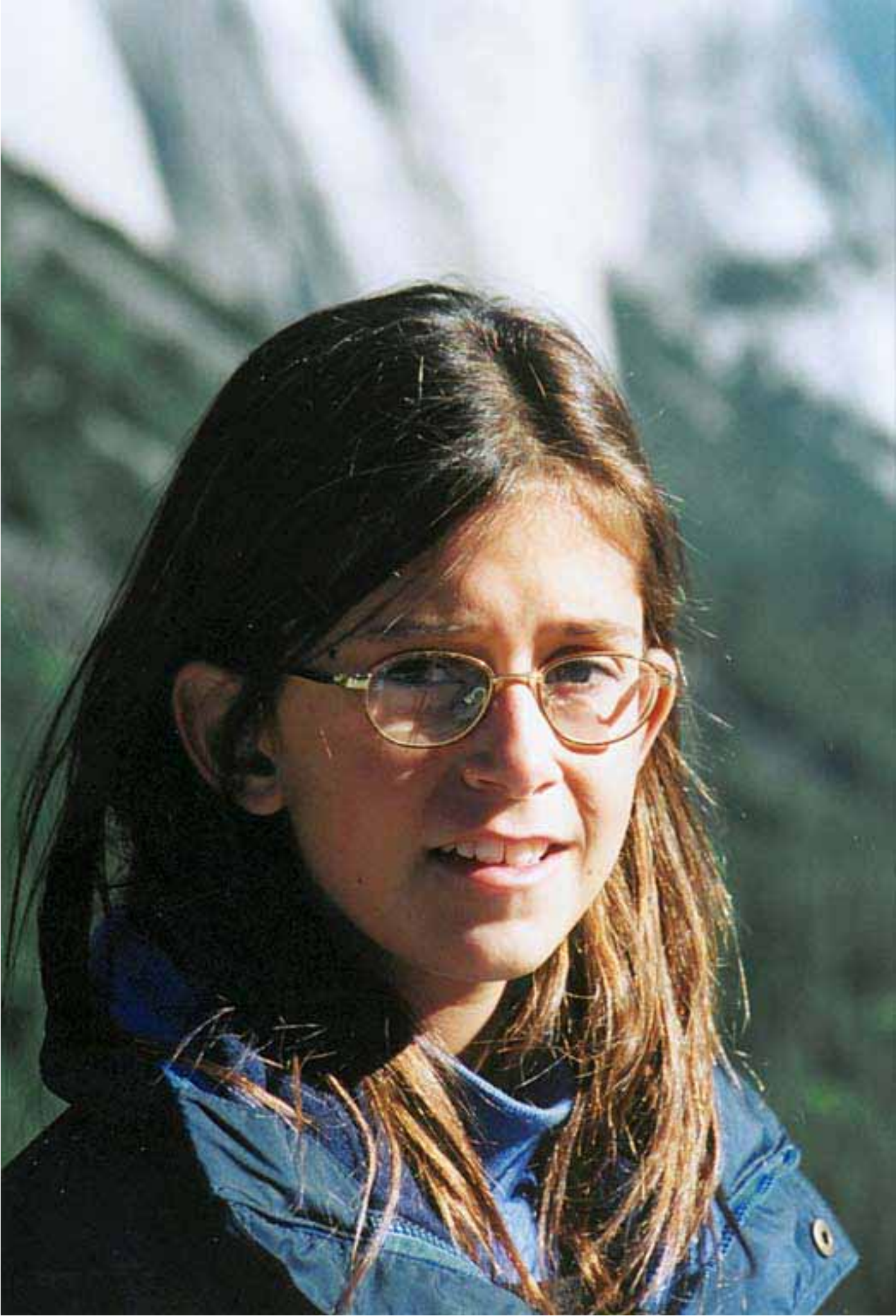
Discovering the
